Please read the following update from Chief and Council

March 23rd, 2022

Chief and Council, during our regular Council meeting on Wednesday March 23rd, 2022 held a discussion on the continued restrictions currently in place and the Community Response Plan as it now stands.

As of Friday April 1st, 2022 all non-resident members will be welcomed back regardless of their COVID-19 vaccination status.

If you have been previously notified by Chief and Council and/or the Anishinabek Police Service that you are not permitted on Beausoleil First Nation territory because of on-going criminal activity, this will continue to be enforced. You will still not be permitted access to our territory.

Ferry Guidelines

Facial coverings will still be required on all public transportation e.g the Indian Maiden, BFN Transit service until April 27th, 2022.

Covid Testing

The Health Centre will continue to provide a Rapid Testing kit for those who request one. The Health Centre will provide guidance to those who test positive and will follow up with the member directly. Once again, we ask that you adhere to and respect the rules that are in place at the Health Centre. Wear a mask at all times, hand sanitize and stay home if you are generally not feeling well.

Lessee Return

The above-noted guidelines do not apply to our seasonal residents. Closer to the opening of the season, we will notify all lessees of the guidelines that may be in place at the time of their return. We thank you all for your continued patience during this trying time, please continue to be safe.
