

Parking Rates and Regulations

Day Parking-

Parking is available for \$15.00 per day. Parking must be in Lots 1 or 2 which are located Approximately 100 ft from the ferry dock.

Ticket must be visible in dash, ensuring date stamp is visible

Night Parking

When arriving at night after the last scheduled ferry Visitors can still pay for parking and collect a paper barcode ticket. Ensure that your ticket is visible on your dash. Parking attendants will check for other vehicles when they arrive on the first scheduled ferry.

30 day pass

These passes are available for \$60.00. Plastic card passes, must be visible in car window. These passes are available from the Lands Administration Office. Contact (705)247-2051 ext 242

Season Pass

Season Parking Passes are available to Cottagers and those who will be using the parking system for longer periods of time.

The cost of these passes are \$250.00 per season (May 1 to Oct.31)

Parking Violations

Non-payment

For those vehicles found in parking areas that do not have a bar code ticket fines will be issued to the owner of the vehicle payable to Beausoleil First Nation.

Fines as follows:

Day 20.00

Weekend 60.00

After 24 to 48 hours of non compliance, and the vehicle is not Moved it will be towed .

Towing costs and storage costs will be the responsibility of the owner of the vehicle.

Towing (Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, s. 100, Parking Lots)

If your vehicle is found to be parked without a valid parking ticket or a visible 30 day or season pass after 24 hours, it will be tagged for towing. If your vehicle gets towed the vehicle owner is responsible for paying the towing charges and any storage costs that will be charged by the Towing company.

Parking Meter

If you find the parking meter not working and it is after the parking attendants have gone. It is your responsibility to call the number displayed on the parking meter, ensuring that when you call if you have to leave a message, make sure you relay the time, date, and your licence plate number, so we can use this if a dispute were to arise.

Designated parking areas

If your vehicle is found outside of the designated parking area, then it will be tagged for towing, unless otherwise advised to park by parking attendants. If this is the case a notation of overflow parking and licence plates will be recorded in a daily log book in the Parking Office located in Dock lane station.

Signage

Signs specifying parking regulations and conditions for parking are to be located when entering the parking area, as well as directly visible from the parking meter.
