

# **BEAUSOLEIL FIRST NATION AWARDS, BURSARIES, SCHOLARSHIPS**

## **Criteria**

- Must be a member of Beausoleil First Nation.
- Must be attending Post Secondary education in the upcoming fall semester.
- Successful recipients will be awarded at the annual Community Graduation Celebration to be held at the Enjimaawnjiding on Thursday, August 18<sup>th</sup>, 2016

The following awards, bursaries and scholarships are available for Beausoleil First Nation students attending post secondary education in the upcoming fall semester:

- **BEAUSOLEIL FIRST NATION YOUTH "STEP UP" AWARD**  
This award is for a Beausoleil First Nation Youth under the age of 22 graduating from secondary school in the current academic year, or those who have graduating and been out of school for no more than two years.
- **BARTLEMAN BURSARY**  
The James Bartleman Bursary is awarded to a high school graduate who is attending post secondary education in the upcoming fall semester.
- **CARL MONAGUE SR. LEADERSHIP AWARD**  
The Carl Monague Sr. Leadership Award is granted to a student who shows leadership and dedication to education as a means of achieving prosperity and success for the Beausoleil First Nation community.
- **DENNIS NGUI-YEN AWARD**  
This award honours the late Dennis Ngui-Yen, a cottager of Christian Island who supported BFN students pursuing post secondary studies in the field of Education.
- **EHWIIDOKAAZAD AWARD**  
This award is for a Georgian College student entering into their first year of studies at Georgian. The 'Ehwiidokaazad' must be seen as a helper in the community.
- **FAITH MARSDEN POST SECONDARY SCHOLARSHIP**  
This scholarship is offered in honour of the late Faith Marsden, who worked tirelessly for the advancement of the early learners of our community.
- **VICTORIA FRANCIS TOBEY MUELLER "BRAVERY" AWARD**  
In honour of Victoria Francis Tobey Mueller, this award is given to a student who demonstrates the desire of achieving their educational goals.

Each award/bursary/scholarship requires an application and written portion to be complete for that specific award. To apply for the awards/bursary/scholarships listed above please contact the Beausoleil First Nation Education Department to receive an application.

Applications must be completed and received by July 31<sup>st</sup> of each year.
