for a Beausoleil First Nation Student**

This Endowment for a Beausoleil First Nation student entering Georgian College was generously donated by Mr. Norman Moffat. Norm came to Christian Island some forty years ago while working as a summer student with Ontario Hydro. A lasting impression was made with the island and the people of the Beausoleil First Nation community. The thought to assist the students was finally realized through the setting up of this endowment. A student's focus on community involvement or giving help to the community 'Ehwiidokaazad' is encouraged in this award.

Application Guidelines:

Who is eligible?

A Beausoleil First Nation Student entering from high school into Georgian College with a proven commitment to community involvement 'Ehwiidokaazad'.

What type of financial assistance is available?

This is a scholarship of \$1000.00 to a Beausoleil First Nation Student entering any program at Georgian College. High school graduate entering Georgian College.

How do I submit the application?

Applications (including documentation and essay) should be submitted in hard copy form to the Education Office in the Beausoleil First Nation Administration Building.

Who do I submit the application to?

Submit application (including documentation and essay) to: Nancy Assance, Education Manager, or Sylvia Norton-Sutherland, Student Support Worker in the Beausoleil First Nation Administration Building.

What do I include in my application?

- 1) Provide a copy of the most current official transcript or report card.
- 2) Provide proof of acceptance into Georgian College.
- 3) Provide a letter of recommendation from a teacher/colleague supporting your application
- 4) Write an essay (750 words) on how you have benefitted from your community involvement and how it has prepared you to succeed at Georgian.

When is the application due?

Applications (including documentation and essay) are due no later than July 31st of each year

Who is the scholarship payable to?

The scholarship is payable to the recipient.
