**You must also include a copy of proof of identity, such as a copy of your Certificate of Indian Status, drivers license, health card, or another document that provides your identity. Do not provide the original document.**

If the Electoral Officer receives this request on or before Friday, May 26, 2023, a mail-in ballot package will be sent to you at the address you provided. If you have any questions, please contact the Electoral Officer.

Please note that the closer to Election Day you make your request, lessens the chance of your completed ballot being successfully received by the Electoral Officer.
