

C O M M U N I Q U E
Effective May 10, 2010

The Chief and Council of the Beausoleil First Nation require credit and criminal reference checks from all new or potential lessees (not applicable to current lessees, **however, if a current lessee wishes to add a family member to their lease a credit check and criminal reference check are required**).

Credit checks will be initiated by the Lands Office (sample Consent to Release Information forms are attached). ****Please note that new or potential lessees will be invoiced for the cost of the credit check.**

Potential lessees must initiate a CPIC on their own, through their closest police detachment and provide to the Lands Office.

These checks must be included with all applications to lease, any renewals of leases or assignments of leases or when deemed appropriate to evaluate the applicants background. The information collected will be used for leasing purposes only. Applications, renewals and assignments of leases will not be considered or approved until receipt of the credit check, criminal reference check and applicable fees are received by the Lands Office.
