RE: AMENDMENT: NOTICE REGARDING ALL PUBLIC BEACHES

Dear Lessee(s),

Please be advised that signage outlining the rules and regulations regarding the use of the beach have been posted at all entrance ways leading to all beaches. We request that everyone be mindful and abide by such rules that have been in effect, as per the Beach By-law No. 20 – dated Jan. 26<sup>th</sup>, 2016.

In the past the Lands & Resources Department have reviewed issues that have been raised regarding the beach at Big Sand Bay. By implementing these rules, it is not the intention of the Lands & Resources Department, nor Beausoleil First Nation to discriminate against anyone with disability barriers. We acknowledge that some of the issues concerning access for individuals with disability barriers needs to be addressed further and some accommodations made.

Therefore, as directed by the Chief & Council of Beausoleil First Nation, Lessees who live with barriers of disability (providing that proof of disability barriers can be furnished) may be granted an exemption to some but not all of the rules implemented. The Lessee can apply to the Lands & Resources Department to be permitted to keep some of their personal belongings on the beach, i.e., Umbrellas, chair, or permitted the use of a golfcart on the beach for the day, after the end of the day items must be relocated to your Leased Lot. Please note: the permitted use of such items as listed above will be for the benefit of the applicant and that applicant only as named on such approval. Each request will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis. Any and all requests must be made in writing to the Lands & Resources Department or the Lessee can make an appointment with our office.

Furthermore, all other items such as, boats, wave runners, sailboats or any form of watercraft/ leisure item <a href="MUST">MUST</a> be removed from all public beach areas. We ask that all permanent and/ or semi-permanent structure, (i.e., storage boxes, containers, benches, winches, picnic tables etc.) be removed immediately. Any items that have not been approved by our office will be confiscated at the owner's expense as per schedule 2 – page 10, of said by-law.
