WE THE COUNCIL OF BEAUSOLEIL FIRST NATION DO HEREBY RESOLVE:

WHEREAS; THE WORLD HEALTH ORGANIZATION HAS DECLARED THE NOVEL CORONAVIRUS (ALSO KNOWN AS COVID-19) OUTBREAK A PANDEMIC AS OF WEDNESDAY MARCH 11TH 2020;

WHEREAS; THE PROVINCE OF ONTARIO HAS REPORTED 42 NEW CASES OF NOVEL CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) IN THE PROVINCE ON SUNDAY MARCH 15TH 2020, RAISING THE PROVINCIAL TOTAL TO 145;

WHEREAS; BEAUSOLEIL FIRST NATION HAS DETERMINED THAT OUR MEMBERSHIP IS AT A GREATER RISK IF THE NOVEL CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) VIRUS SPREADS TO THE COMMUNITY;

WHEREAS; THE CHIEF AND COUNCIL OF BEAUSOLEIL FIRST NATION HAS A DUTY TO PROTECT THE MEMBERSHIP OF BEAUSOLEIL FIRST NATION, WHICH INCLUDES OUR KNOWLEDGE KEEPERS, LANGUAGE SPEAKERS, ELDERS, CHILDREN AND GENERAL POPULATION;

WHEREAS; THE EMERGENCY CONTROL GROUP (ECG) HAS DETERMINED THAT BEAUSOLEIL FIRST NATION DOES NOT HAVE THE ADEQUATE SUPPLIES IN THE COMMUNITY TO COMBAT THE SPREAD OF THE NOVEL CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19);

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED; THAT BEAUSOLEIL FIRST NATION CHIEF AND COUNCIL OFFICIALLY DECLARE THE NOVEL CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) A THREAT TO THE COMMUNITY;

AND FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED; THAT BEAUSOLEIL FIRST NATION MAKES A DECLARATION OF A COMMUNITY EMERGENCY, EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY, AND IS IN EFFECT UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE.
