Greetings Everyone,

As of Monday, October 3, 2022 there will no longer be delivery of parcels to the Christian Island Mail Office. Residents will still be able to pick up their mail (letter mail and parcels) delivered by Canada Post.

Parcels shipped using couriers other than Canada Post will be delivered and sorted for pick-up at the Cedar Point Receiving Office. The general receiver will notify residents they have a package, please make sure you provide your preferred method of contact.


As you know, there have been challenges with staffing as well as transporting the mail from Cedar Point to Christian Island. We will be posting for relief workers to assist with staffing and transportation issues.

Effective immediately, mail will be picked up daily (except weekends\holidays) on the ferry departing Christian Island at 1:00 pm and returning from Cedar Point on the 1:30 pm ferry. To allow time for the mail clerk to sort the mail, mail delivered the same day will only be available for pick up after 3:30 pm.

The new Chimnissing Canada Post Outlet is tentatively scheduled to open on Monday, October 24, 2022. We will provide a further update regarding hours of operation and services offered.
